## 2024 Snapshot



Through our ongoing Ho'ōla Nā Mana'o Program, **259** requests were fulfilled in 2024.



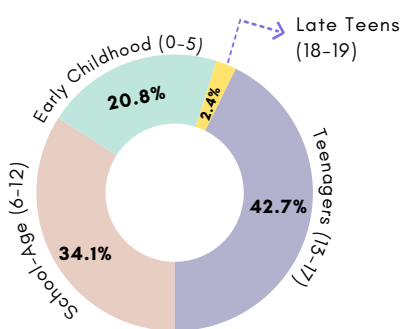
We packed **320** backpacks with school supplies for our Back-to-School Drive, preparing youth for the upcoming school year.



The Friends fulfilled **1,016** requests for assistance last year across all programs, helping a total of **782** children.

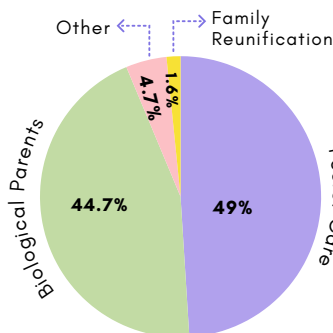


We purchased and wrapped presents for **437** children through our Holiday Gift Project



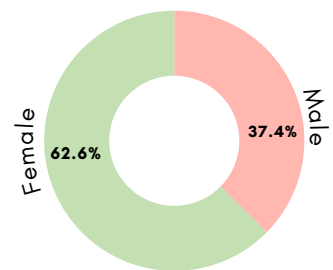
### AGE GROUP

The Ho'ōla Nā Mana'o program supports children of all ages. Here, you can see the wide range of child victims we serve per age group.



### YOUTH PLACEMENT

In 2024, the majority of youth served were in foster care (49%) or with biological parents (44.7%), highlighting diverse family dynamics supported.



### GENDER DATA

In 2024, 62.2% of youth served were female and 37.4% male. With 1 in 4 females and 1 in 6 males experiencing sexual abuse, there is a significant need for gender-sensitive care.
